*the South east quarter of the North east quarter of Section four in Township thirteen of Range Seventeen in the District of, Lands subject to Sale at Chillicothe Ohio, containing forty one Acres, and fifty four hundredths of an Acre,*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR**

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights,

privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *George Kimble*

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
