 belonging and the profits thereof. To have and to hold the premises thereby conveyed  
 with the appurtenances unto the said Samuel Lewis and to the sole and only proper use  
 benefit and behoof of the said Samuel Lewis his heirs and assigns forever provided always  
 and these presents are of this express conditions that if the said Oliver Trimble his heirs
