part witnesseth that the said Oliver Scimble for and in consideration of the sum of  
Thirty two Dollars and thirty nine cents to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Lewis  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold to the said  
Samuel Lewis and to his heirs and assigns forever the following tract or parcel of  
land to wit the north half of the west half of the south east quarter of section number  
Three of Township number thirteen of Range number seventeen (within the County  
of Hocking) Together with all and singular the hereditaments thereunto in anywise  
belonging and the profits thereof. To have and to hold the premises hereby conveyed  
with the appurtenances unto the said Samuel Lewis and to the sole and only use and benefit  
and behoef of the said Samuel Lewis his heirs and assigns forever to hold always  
and these presents are of this present conditions that if the said Oliver Scimble his heirs  
Executors or Administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said  
Samuel Lewis or his legal representative the sum of thirty two dollars and thirty nine  
cents on or before the twentieth day of September next ensuing the date hereof together  
with the interest which may accrue thereon in a manner particularly specified in
