During small pox epidemic Joseph was isolated in what was called the Pot House. He got Irrisiditis from another man that was with him. This caused a nasty sore on his nose. People thought it was cancer, but it was Irrisiditis. Joseph wore a patch on his nose throughout his life. Because of this he didn't want his picture taken. Little is known of his early youth, schooling if any, or trades he may have worked at.
